Pastor's Update

March 6, 2024

Friends,

Our Lenten Journey is nearly half way over. We are continuing to celebrate, prepare, and consider our lives of faith. Wesley talked about this in terms of holiness. This week I want to take a moment to talk about what Holiness means to us as United Methodists.

Picture first what holiness is in your mind, you might imagine several things. The image of a saint, a family member, or a pastor might come to mind. For me I think of Mrs. Faye from growing up in Brinkley FUMC. She was one of those people who knew everything and behaved in the way that you might expect holiness to look. I also think of Dr. Jay McDaniel from Hendrix, who was always invested in looking at the spirituality of whatever question you asked him. They both have something in common, centeredness and inquisitive natures.

I don't imagine that they just happened upon those personalities, but rather they cultivated their connection to God over time. John Wesley would certainly believe that this was the case when it comes to personal holiness. John was the type that believed in active participation in his faith life. At Oxford he founded a group with Charles that spent hours a day in prayer together and when working on a little start up called Methodism he made the defining characteristic the class meeting. A place where a small group gathered not to discuss the Bible but to reflect upon their holiness, that is their current relationship to God.

Lent is a time for us to do the same. Perhaps you gave up something. Perhaps you took something on instead. Regardless, I encourage you to remember that Lent is not a "New Years Resolution Second Attempt", but rather a chance to examine yourself and your relationship with God. I encourage you to ask yourself the question of what is in between me and God? and to consider why it's still there.

A Year in the Bible with Pastor Chad




